Job Duties:

- Encourage community participation and facilitate cultivation of friendships/connections within the various communities of people served
- Provide guidance and direction on social and judgement issues, health and safety issues, and other issues pertaining to activities of daily living and community integration of people served
- Arrange transportation to and from various places/businesses in the community and events within the community
- Maintain all documentation of services rendered (ex: summary should reflect progress, outcomes, dates services were provided, barriers with implementation, achievements, projected planning goals, and concerns)
- Attend staff training and meetings as scheduled
- Perform other duties as assigned

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities Required:

- Bachelor's degree required
- Minimum of 1 (one) year of demonstrated expertise working with people with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities preferred
- Must have the ability to mitigate and facilitate positive interactions/connections with the community
- Must have the understanding and ability to navigate/document various community services
- Must have or obtain knowledge of the various state waiver programs and services for people served
- Must have excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Must have excellent organizational skills
- Knowledge of appropriate documentation and standards per Alabama Department of Mental Health preferred
- Must have reliable transportation and a valid Alabama driver's license; must be insurable by the agency's insurance
- Must be able to pass pre-employment screening

Physical Requirements:

- Frequent standing, walking, hand dexterity, reaching with hands and arms, climbing or balancing, stooping; kneeling, crouching, crawling, and speaking and listening both near and long distances; Must have vision abilities that include close vision, distance vision, color vision and depth perception
- Occasional sitting required
- Frequent lifting and/or moving more than 100 pounds
